### Market Area Transportation

Greater Syracuse is a nexus for the movement of goods and people throughout the Northeast. Located in the center of New York State on the southern shore of Lake Ontario, the [Syracuse - Auburn Combined Statistical Area \(CSA\)](#) is a 3,400 square mile land area composed of 4 counties: Cayuga, Madison, Onondaga and Oswego.

The City of Syracuse, located in Onondaga County, is the region's major metropolitan center. Appropriately called the "Crossroads of the Northeast", its central location and a well-developed transportation network include an International Airport, Interstate Highway intersection, and intermodal center.
